Patrol Challenge 2

Your Entrance

In a big camp it's fun and practical to define an entrance to your campsite. This also helps friends you make in camp to come and visit.

The entrance should include:

- A sign to define who you are (Patrol name)
- Members names
- Where you are from (home troop name)

When defining an entrance you should also consider a few things such as safety, clear of hazards and placed practically to your eating shelter and sleeping tents. Because if it's not practical, nobody will use it.

The Challenge

1. Make an entrance sign on cardboard or similar for your Patrol camp.
2. In your Patrol, discuss what makes a good entrance and what you need to consider in choosing the location.
3. Record your findings and take them back to the troop meeting.
4. Troop can review your findings and give you a score out of 3 for your signs (as per the dot points in the green box).
